A maximum of \$2000 will be awarded annually based on the recommendations of the Laura Ford Student Scholarship Committee; the application deadline is May 15th.

To be eligible to apply for the Laura Ford Student Scholarship, an applicant must be:

1. A VSRT member.
2. Enrolled in an approved program of radiography for no less than six (6) months.
3. Students in the second year of radiography program must be planning on immediately continuing their education in a prescribed graduate program, i.e., nuclear medicine, radiology administration, radiologic education, radiation oncology, special procedures, or sonography.

Commonwealth Radiology P.C. Ronald F. Calkins, M.D. Memorial Scholarship

To be eligible for the scholarship the student must: Submit application by the posted deadline and

1. Be enrolled in the second level at the Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital School of Medical Imaging.
2. Attain past and future successful (80%) completion of all coursework
3. Exhibit professionalism in the classroom and clinical environments
4. No record of programmatic probation or incurred clinical disciplinary action (including, but not limited to, written letters of warning).
